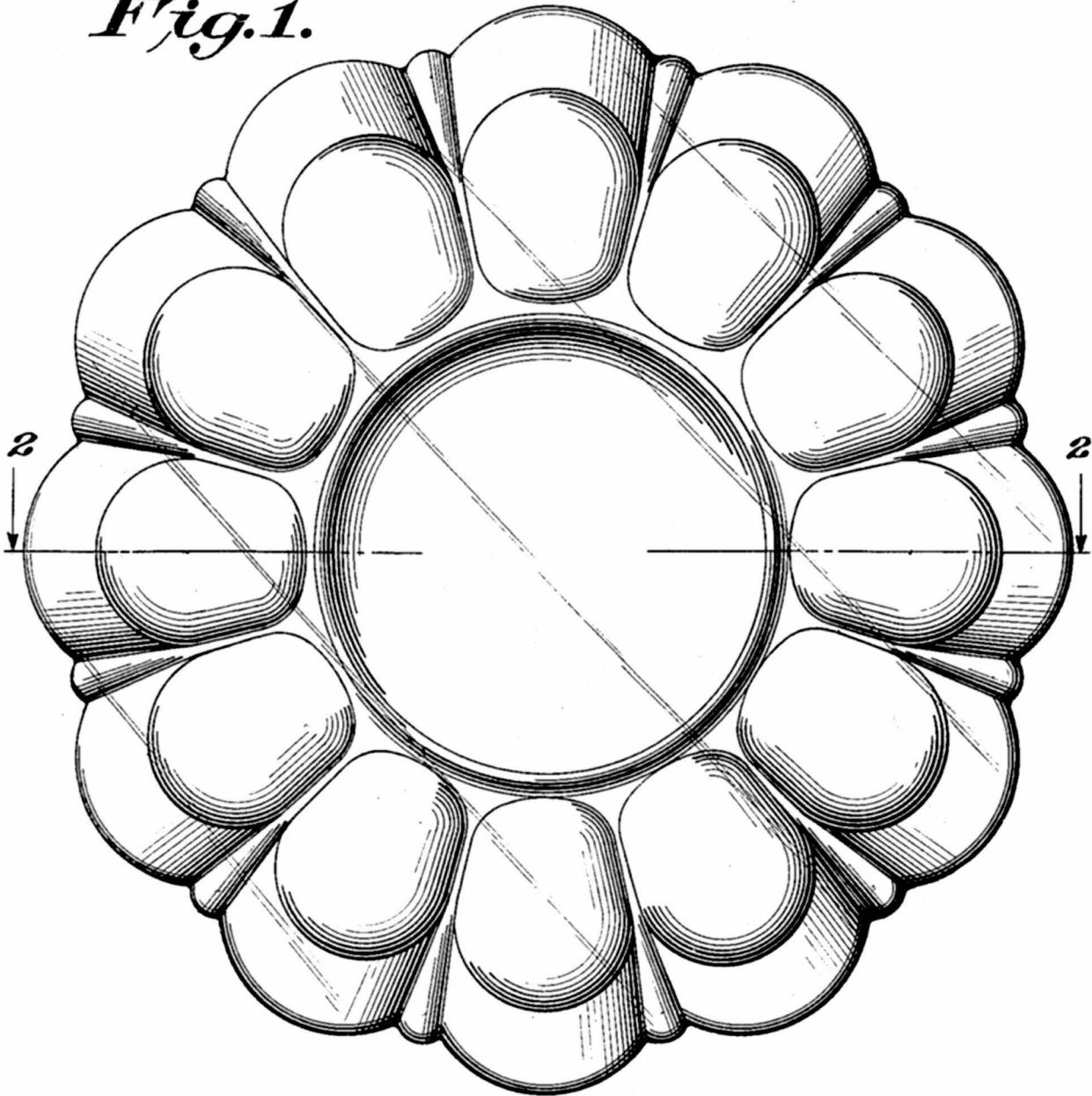
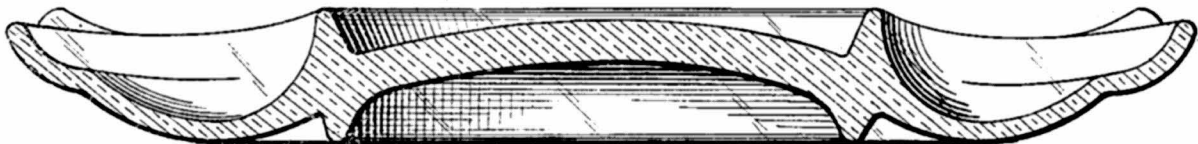

DESIGN FOR A DEVEILED EGG PLATE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Arthur J. Bennett, a citizen of the United States of America and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Deviled Egg Plate or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:

Figure 1 is a bottom plan view of a deviled egg plate or similar article, showing my new design; and

Figure 2 is a sectional view taken on line 2—2 of Fig. 1.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a deviled egg plate or similar article, substantially as shown.
