

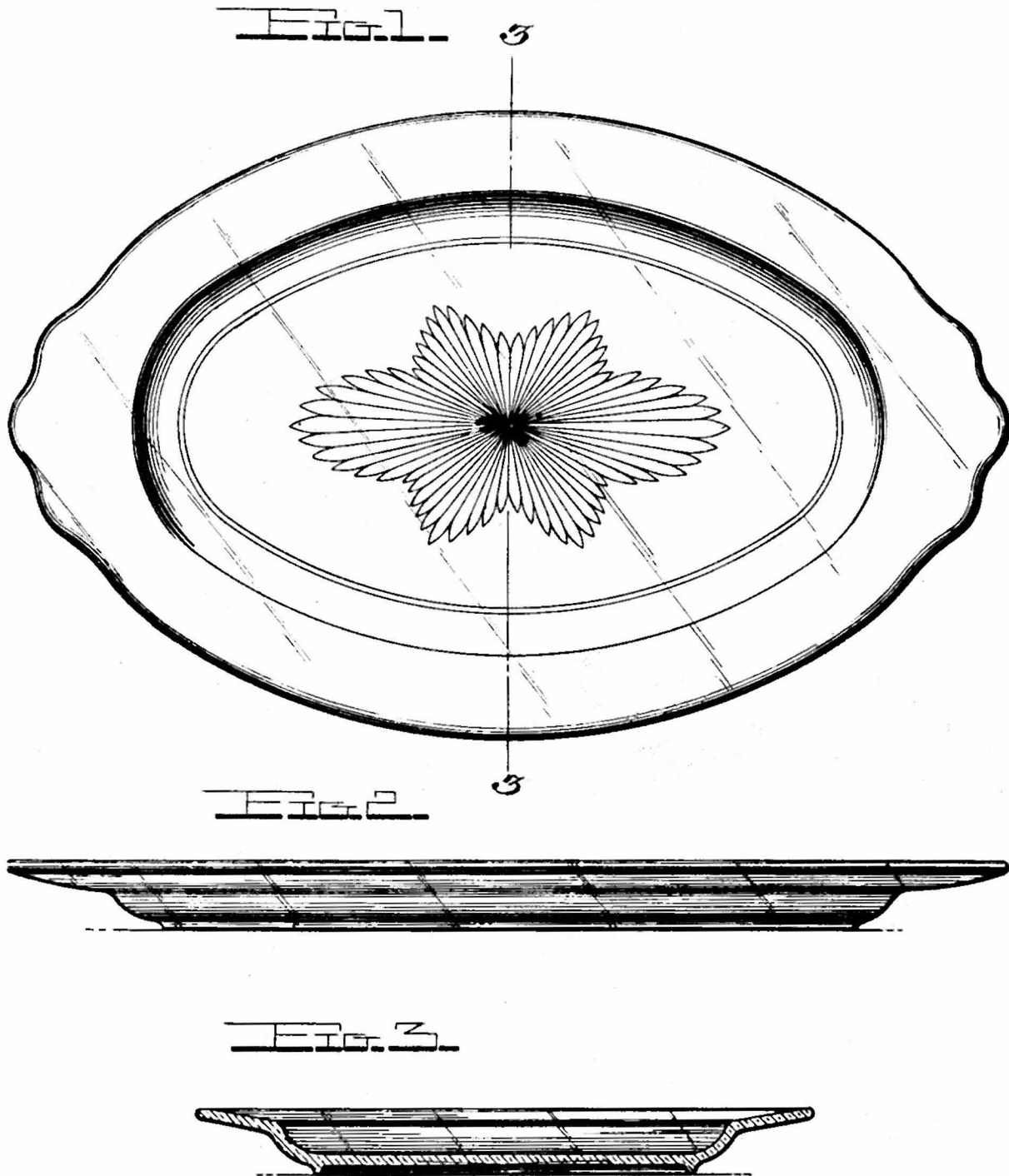

ARTHUR J. BENNETT, OF CAMBRIDGE, OHIO.

DESIGN FOR A PLATTER OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.

Application filed September 1, 1927. Serial No. 23,273. Term of patent 7 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ARTHUR J. BENNETT, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cambridge, in the county of Guernsey and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Platter or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan of a platter or similar article, showing my new design, and

Figure 2 is a side elevation of Fig. 1, and

Figure 3 is a section on line 3—3 of Fig. 1.

A material feature of the invention resides in the central figure composed of petal-like parts, which figure is of considerably less

width than length, and which in outline harmonizes with the generally oval outline of the platter or similar article and is surrounded by faint spaced oval lines and by an oval concaved part, the latter merging into the rim. The rim has a plain upper face and curved sides and at each end has three similarly curved parts of which the central one extends outwardly from the end of the rim while the two remaining ones project outwardly from the plain rim sides and merge thereinto, in concave lines.

I claim:—

The ornamental design for a platter or similar article as shown and described.
