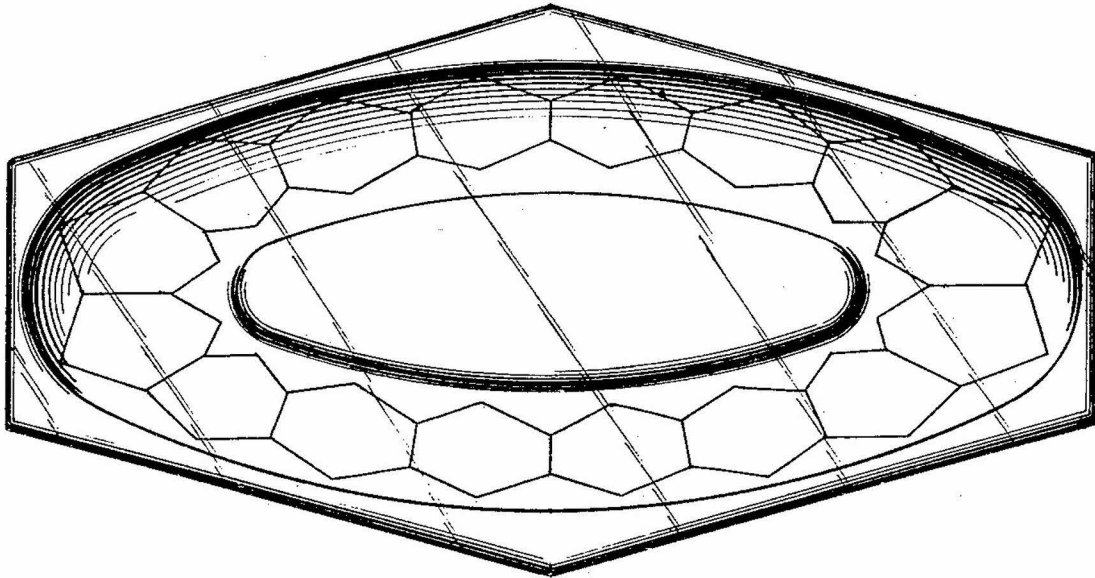

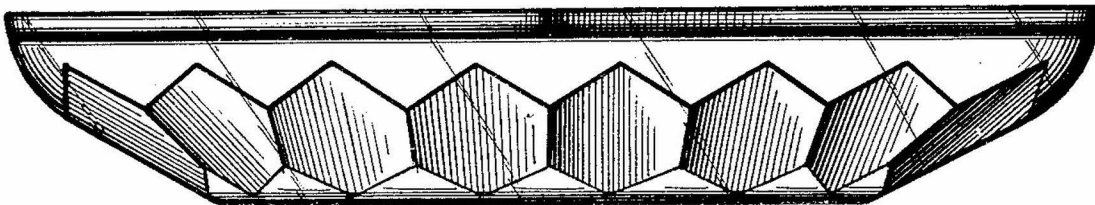

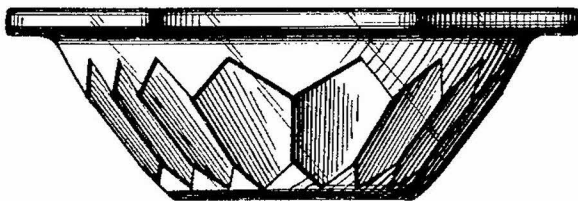
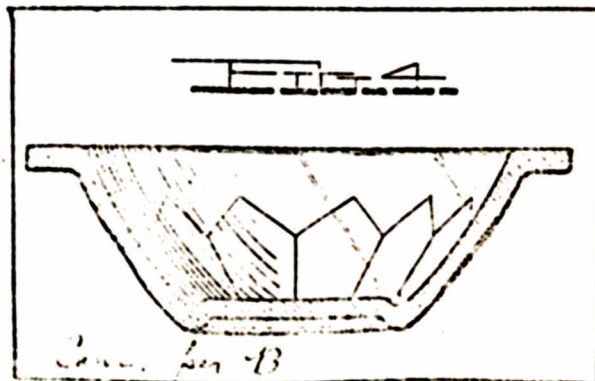

DESIGN FOR A TRAY OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed June 29, 1929. Serial No. 31,887. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JESS C. KELLY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cambridge, in the county of Guernsey and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Tray or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of the tray showing my new design,

Fig. 2 is a side elevation,

Fig. 3 is an end elevation.

The dominant feature of the design resides in the surface ornamentation.

The ornamental design for a tray or similar article, as shown, and described.
