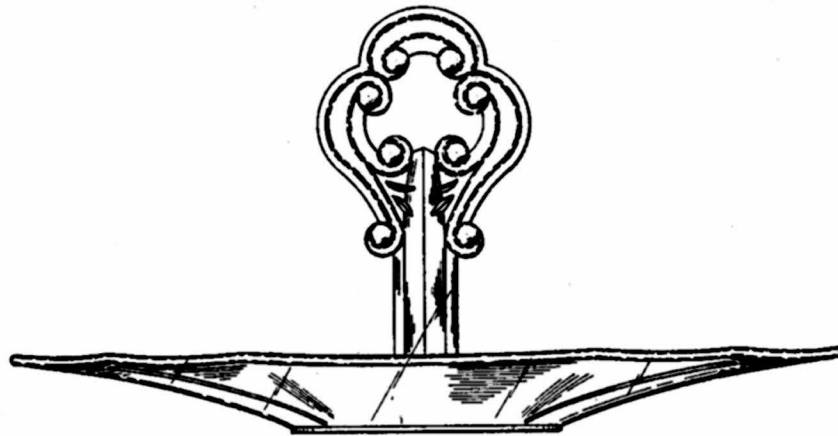

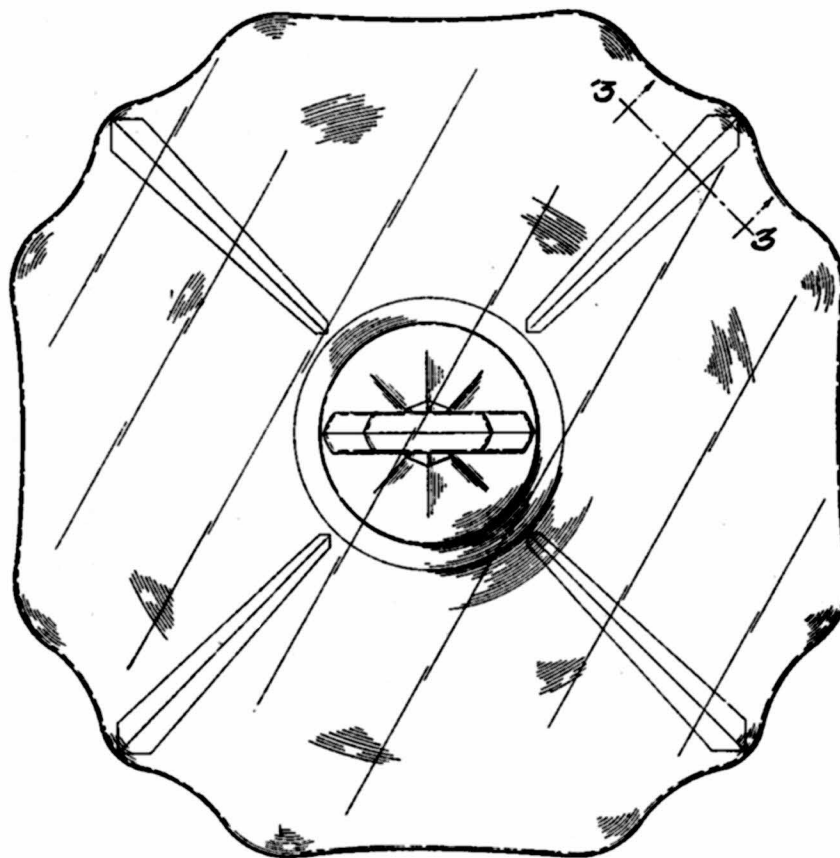

DESIGN FOR A SANDWICH TRAY OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed February 28, 1930. Serial No. 34,696. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILL CAMERON McCARTNEY, a citizen of the United States of America, and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Sandwich Tray or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, in which—

Figure 1 is a side elevation of a sandwich tray, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a top plan view of the same; and—

Figure 3 is a section on line 3—3, Fig. 2.

The essential feature of the invention resides in the four side portions of the tray

each having a single central convex edge and a single pair of similar concave edges, and the four ribs on the bottom of the tray of tapering and substantially prism form that have their outer wide ends terminating at the convex edges of said side portions, combined with the circular pedestal for the handle, the pedestal being of relatively small diameter and being surrounded by a ring from which the ribs radiate.

I claim—

The ornamental design for a sandwich tray or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
