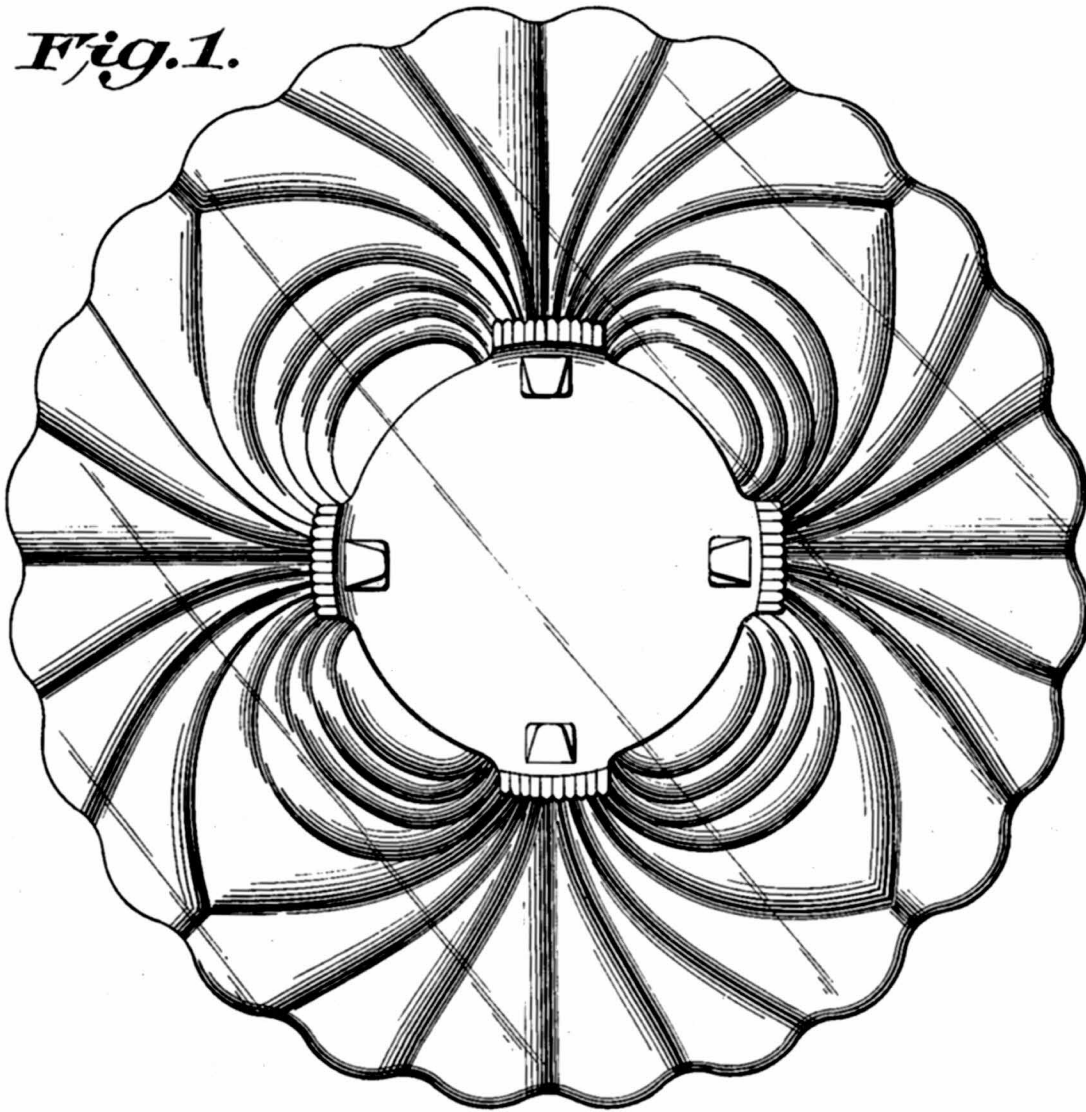
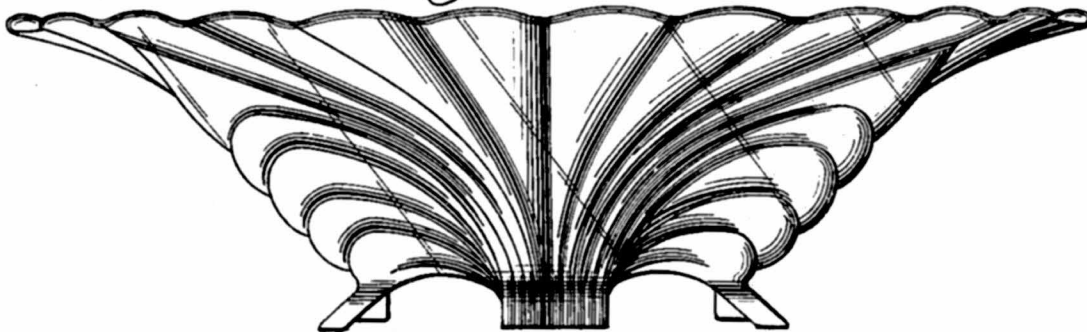

DESIGN FOR A BOWL OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Arthur James Bennett, Cambridge, Ohio

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Arthur James Bennett, a citizen of the United States of America and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bowl or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a bottom plan view of a bowl, showing my new design; and—

Figure 2 is a side elevational view of the same. The upper surface is smooth, and the configuration of the lower surface is visible therethrough when made of transparent material.

I claim—

The ornamental design for a bowl or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
